

Jews treat the name of God with the greatest respect. They also try to live by the Ten Commandments. They are values that Jews try to keep and include using God's name with respect, remembering the Sabbath, respecting your parents and not lying or stealing. Jews believe God gave the Ten Commandments to Moses in Hebrew. A synagogue is a place of worship for Jews and is central to community life. The making of images is forbidden, so synagogues are unlikely to feature pictures or statues of important Jewish figures. Pesach, or Passover, is an important Jewish holiday that commemorates the liberation of Hebrew slaves in Egypt, who were led out of Egypt by Moses. Passover takes place during the spring, on the 15th day of the Hebrew month, Nisan. During the celebration families have a special meal called Seder. All the foods on the plate represent something from the story of Passover. The foods are: Matzah (bread), Charoset (dried fruit), Zeroah (lamb), Beitzah (egg), Maror (bitter herb), Karpas (parsley), Chazeret (lettuce).
