It has the Mediterranean Sea on its east and the Atlantic Ocean in the north, west and south coast. The capital city of Spain is Madrid.


Travel - how can you get there?

The easiest and quickest way is by aeroplane. It is possible to travel by train to Spain in a day. The fastest route is to take the Eurostar from London. Then change in France to Barcelona. You can also get a ferry from Portsmouth or Plymouth to Northern Spain.

Compare to the UK - The UK is in the northwest of Europe. Spain is in southwest of Europe. In the UK, we speak English, Welsh and Gaelic. In Spain, they speak Spanish. The UK flag is red, white and blue. The Spanish flag is red and yellow.

Tourist attractions – La Sagrada Familia cathedral in Barcelona is one of the most beautiful buildings in the world. The Royal palace in Madrid is the official residence of the Spanish royal family. In Valencia there is a City of Arts and Science Museum. The Plaza de España in Seville is a famous square which features a canal.
