Vocabulary

- Pattern – a design that repeats
- Motif - the starting point of any pattern is the single element that will be repeated
- Regular pattern – the motif is repeated in a way that is predictable
- Irregular pattern – the motif changes or the way it is repeated is unpredictable
- Symmetrical pattern - the same on both sides
- Mood board – A place to show ideas of colours, shapes and textures
- Observational skills – Look carefully and notice things
- Collage - Using different materials to make a picture
- Media - Different drawing tools and materials that are used to make art
- Self-portrait – A picture of yourself
- Compare – think about how something is the same or different
- Reflect - Think about your work and how successful you were
- Evaluate - Think about what you would do next time
