Year 6 National Curriculum Assessments

Dear Parents & Carers,

We will be holding a meeting on **Monday 6th February at 8.50am** in the school hall for Year Six parents and carers to share information about the National Curriculum Assessments, which will be taking place in May 2023. This meeting will then be repeated **at 6:00pm** via TEAMS.

It is not necessary to attend both meetings.

Please find below the TEAMS link to the meeting. If you don't already have the TEAMS app, you may need to download this prior to the meeting. We plan to open the meeting 5 minutes earlier than the start time, so that everyone can check they have access and can see the screen that we will be sharing during the meeting.

If you are unable to attend the meeting, the presentation from the meeting will be available on our school website under our Teaching and Learning tab. From here, on the drop-down menu, select National Curriculum Assessments. It will be available from Tuesday 7th February.

The National Curriculum Assessments (SATs) are really important in relation to the information that we are required to share with ALL secondary schools. At transition meetings for secondary schools, we are asked by the receiving Year 7 team for the children's predicted attainment in their SATs. This is then followed up with their actual attainment with their transfer documents. The SATs also allow the children to demonstrate that they are working at age related expectations in Year 6 and this gives them a good grounding for the next steps in their educational journey.
