A few reminders...

- Only dark coloured (navy or black) joggers/leggings should be worn for PE
- School shoes should be worn at all times except for PE days
- School skirts should not be too short
- Only studs for pierced ears and no additional jewellery other than a watch.
- Hair longer than shoulder length should be tied up at all times
- No smart watches

Early Birds

Please can I remind you that our school gates do not open until 8:30am in the morning. This is when a member of staff is present on the playground to support supervision and be a port of call if needed. We do ask that you stay with your children (exceptions to Year 5 and Year 6) until the whistle is blown at 8:40am. I am seeing an increase in the number of children who are standing outside the school gates and along the pavement for quite a length of time. These children are not being supervised and we do worry about them. Please can I ask that your child/children do not arrive any earlier than 8:30am.
