



Vocabulary

- Art movement – a group of artists following the same style
- Surrealism – artists made dream-like scenes and showed situations that would be strange or impossible in real life
- Optical Illusion - colour, light and pattern are used to create images that can be deceptive or misleading to our brains
- Texture – we can create different effects to show how something would feel when touched
- Tone - The lightness or darkness of a colour
- Blend – Combine two colours together
- Medium- Different drawing tools and materials that are used to make art
- Composition - the way in which different elements of an artwork are combined or arranged
