Dear Parents & Carers,

As you know, our last day on site for all of the children is Friday 14th July 2023 (3:20pm). However, this is not the last day of our school year. With the Wirral Golf Open Championships in our local area, we had to make changes to our school term dates. These were shared with you some time ago.

Therefore, **Monday 17th July 2023 is the last official school day** for the children, but this will need to take place through Online/Home Learning. **All children are expected to attend their two Teams meetings on this date – it is a compulsory school day.** Teachers have planned a range of learning opportunities that the children can work through on Monday.

Prior to Monday, class teachers will speak with the children about how the day will be structured and explain the different learning opportunities.

Below are all of the links that you should need for the day. Please scroll down and find the correct class. There is a morning link and an afternoon link. Each of the meetings last for 20 minutes. We have done our best to stagger them so that devices can be shared at home.

When the children log onto the Teams meeting, we ask that they mute themselves and add their name to the chat. We will be completing the school register, which is a legal requirement of any school day. Any children who are not attending are expected to report their absence in the normal way, which is by contacting the School Office, either via a phone call or an email. Any children who do not attend the Teams meeting and we do not have a reported reason for their absence will receive a phone call from The School Office.
