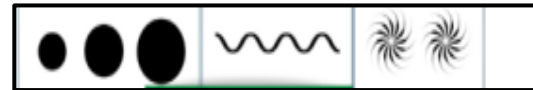
Singing

- We warm up our voices before singing.

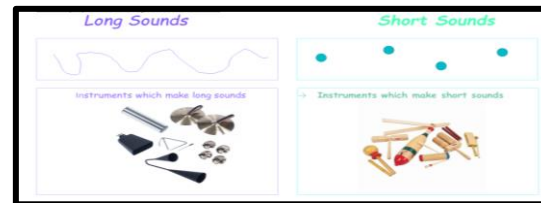



- We can draw our own symbols or images to record the sounds we play and then others can follow them.

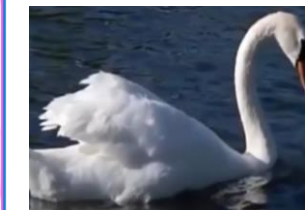
