


What is a chord?



A chord is a group of notes played together to create harmony.





Chords are usually made up of the 1st, 3rd and 5th degrees of the scale. This is called a triad

Listening and Singing



We can sing two-part songs, pop songs, and Christmas Carols to celebrate the season.

Key Vocabulary

Scale – a range of notes played in order.	Chord triads – 1 st , 3 rd and 5 th notes of a scale
Staff notation - notes on a stave of 5 lines	Ascending – going up in pitch
Descending - going down in pitch	Treble clef - a musical symbol to show a range of pitch
Major scale - a happy sounding range of notes	Minor scale - a sad sounding range of notes

A call-and-response method is like a conversation in music.

Notes can be written as letter names: ABCDEFG - ABCDEFG There are 8 notes in an octave.
