Democracy	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Children explore issues such as democracy in their historical context and relate them to the modern day through studying periods such as Ancient Greece. This enables the students to understand how, overtime, changes happened and to evaluate their impact in modern societies.• Children are given the opportunity to find out a range of historical events allowing them to gain an understanding of chronology.
Rule of Law	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• We consider how life has changed for people over time and how rules and laws have changed and shaped civilisations to ensure society is happy, secure and safe.
Individual Liberty	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Children engage in debates, allowing for freedom of speech and different views to be heard and expressed.• By looking at the achievements of influential people across the world and significant black individuals' children develop an awareness of how they have influenced and shaped the country and world in which we live. This includes an appreciation of their work.
Mutual Respect	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Children learn about different periods in history where they develop an awareness and appreciation of other cultures and historical events through time.
Tolerance of those with different faiths and beliefs	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Teaching students to respect and value diversity is encouraged in the day-to-day teaching and learning through showing respect for different viewpoints and ideas as well as in the ability to work effectively together both individually and in groups. We approach the teaching of history with an awareness to children's different faiths and beliefs.
