Dear Parents & Carers,

Year 1 – Year 6 Interim Reports

Please find attached to this email your child's Interim Report following our autumn term assessments, which took place just before the Christmas holidays.

As you know, we really value your feedback and following our summer 2022 Parent & Carer survey we have amended the way that we structure our Interim Reports and how we present the information to you. We hope that these changes make it easier to understand the assessments of your child and how you can offer further support at home.

At the top of the Interim Report you will find your child's name, their current year group and their class teacher(s).

Following this you will see a percentage for your child's attendance. This is a percentage based on your child's attendance over the whole of the autumn term (September 2022 to December 2022). 97% is the expected attendance for all compulsory aged school children. We know that there are times when children are poorly and when this is the case the best place for them is at home so that they can make a full recovery. At all other times, your child is expected to be in school to ensure that their attendance is as close to 100% as possible. Holidays should not be booked in Term Time. Please ensure that you have an up to date copy of the Term Dates for this year ([Click here for 2022-2023 Term Dates](#)) or use the calendar on our school website. We ask that all Parents and Carers share and echo the really important message that **'every day counts at school.'** If your child's attendance is under 97%, this will be being monitored and further steps may be put into place in line with our attendance policy ([Click Here for WKPS Attendance Policy](#)). At WKPS we want to ensure that we support all children to be as successful as possible and to do this, they need to have the expected attendance - 97% or above.

Next are the assessments for your child in Reading, Writing, Maths and Science (Core Subjects). Your child has been assessed by their class teacher using a range of different methods, both formal and informal. For each Core Subject your child has been assessed as either Working **Towards** Age Related Expectations, Working **At** Age Related Expectations or Working **Above** Age Related Expectations. This is based on the expectations at this point (December 2022) in the academic year.

Moving down the Interim Report, you will see that your child's class teacher has made a judgement in relation to your child's behaviour and effort. Behaviour takes into account, behaviour in the classroom, behaviour around school and behaviour at play time/lunch time.

At the end of the Interim Report there is a comment made by the class teacher as to how you can support your child further at home. Class teachers have selected an element that they feel would be the most beneficial at this point in the school year.

We hope that the new style Interim Reports are easier to understand and that they give you valuable information about your child.

However, if you do have any questions about your child's report, please do not hesitate to contact your child's class teacher using the key stage emails. The key stage emails are picked up by phase leaders and will be sent to the relevant class teacher in order for you to receive a response.
